Day 1 Saturday, May 27 (D)

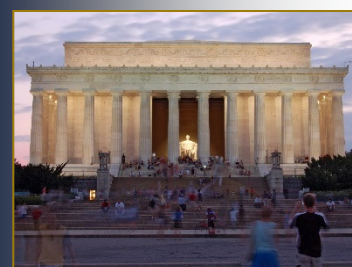
- 10:30am Depart from Los Angeles via Alaska Airlines Flight #310
 6:35pm Arrival in Washington, D.C.
 Meet your Tour Manager, *Alan Feldman*, who will escort the group through the duration of the tour
 8:15pm Dinner at Red Robin in Falls Church
 Check-in to the Hilton McLean Tysons Corner

Day 2 Sunday, May 28 (B,D)

- 6:30am Breakfast at the hotel
 8:30am Board motorcoach and depart hotel
 Panoramic motorcoach tour of Historic Washington, D.C., including a visit to Lafayette Square for a photo opportunity of the White House
 10:00am Visit the Smithsonian Institution's American History & Natural History Museums (at leisure)
 Lunch, on own
 1:00pm Visit the hallowed grounds of Arlington National Cemetery, take part in *Flowers of Remembrance Day* at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier (*School/Government Issued ID required for entry for 16 years and older*)

 Walking tour of the Lincoln, Korean, Martin Luther King, Jr., Vietnam, and the National World War II Memorial (as time permits)

 8:00pm Attend the official *National Memorial Day Concert* on the West Lawn of the U.S. Capitol, featuring the National Symphony Orchestra and broadcast live on PBS. This Memorial Day Concert will finish with a breathtaking fireworks display over D.C. presented by the Presidential Salute Guns Battery of the 3rd United States Army Infantry Regiment

- 2:00pm** ***Participation in the 2023 National Memorial Day Parade on Historic Constitution Avenue***
- 6:30pm Dinner at Catholic University Pryzbyla Student Center
- 8:30pm Return to the hotel for overnight

Day 4 Tuesday, May 30 (B)
